

K – 12 Privacy Statements

The following statements describe the responsibilities of school districts and the rights and expectations of students, staff and parents/guardians in relation to privacy.

- Students and parents/guardians have a reasonable expectation of privacy, and that their personal information will be protected.
- Students and parents/guardians have the right to request access to School District records, including those that may contain their own personal information.
- School Districts have the responsibility to respect and protect the privacy of students, parents, guardians and staff and any personal information that is collected, used, disclosed, stored and accessed.
- School Districts are committed to being transparent about their information management practices and will respond to requests for access to records.
- Staff are responsible for understanding and protecting the privacy rights of students and parents/guardians.
- Staff also have a right to privacy, and an expectation that their personal information will be protected by their school district.
